Sheila McKague: Bursary honouree for 2011

Sheila has been a member of University of Regina Women for over twenty years, having joined when her husband became chancellor in 1989. She has held many executive positions and served as President from 2001-2003. She coordinating the Eclectic Events Group when it started, and remains a member of the International Food Group and of Book Club #1.

Sheila has elected to award the bursary to a deserving student studying **social work**. She has kindly provided the following explanation of her choice.

"For a number of years prior to my retirement, I was a teacher/counsellor in an alternate high school designed for students who had dropped out of mainstream high school because of special challenges. Often my students came from dysfunctional families or had parenting responsibilities with little outside support. It was always satisfying to assist these students so that they were able to complete grade twelve, some of them going on to the University of Regina. Over the years of volunteering at Convocation Receptions, it has been gratifying to see some of those same students celebrating their graduation from the U of R, most often in education and social work.

Given the contact many of these students had over the years with social workers, it seemed appropriate for me to direct the U of R Women's Bursary to the Faculty of Social Work. It has been my observation that many of those enrolled in social work are mature students who are juggling academic demands and the financial costs of university with the responsibilities of raising a family. As well, even when these students graduate and become employed, salaries in the field of social work are not high.

Assisting a deserving social work student through this bursary is a way of 'giving back' for the assistance my students received from some of the social workers I came to respect during my years at the alternate school."
