## **METHODS**


- Application is hosted on firebase, which provides pre-built user authentication
- Firebase's real time database and storage is used to store and dynamically load data in real time
- React JS provided web app manifest and service worker, which allows the app to behave properly on a mobile device

# **FUTURE IMPROVEMENTS**

- Push notifications that alerts users when a report status is updated
- Have two user pools for each set of users
- Include different ministries that handle reports in the province and also branch out to other provinces in Canada

### **OBJECTIVES**

- Provide a Web Application that can be used seamlessly on any device
- Allow citizens to take a picture of road hazards in their area and submit their report
- Allow citizens to see all approved reports
- Allow citizens to track the status of their submitted reports
- Allow the City of Regina to easily view, approve and monitor reports.
